

- 13 Virginia Dare Winery Two Arrowheads (Paso Robles): 2 flowery heads Viognier & Roussanne that certainly aren't butting heads. \$23 B+>> find this wine<<
- 13 Dierberg Pinot Noir Dierberg Vineyard (Santa Maria Valley): This one must be fretting over bold, nuanced matters of great import. \$44 A->> find this wine <<
- 13 Dierberg Chardonnay Dierberg Vineyard (Santa Maria Valley): Power and perfume, and probably enough that it ought to cost you more. \$32 A->> find this wine <<
- 15 Donnafugata Sherazade Nero d'Avola (Sicilia): About as femininely lovely a intro to Sicily's heroic Nero as could be provided. \$20

  B+>> find this wine <<
- 15 Donnafugata SurSur Grillo (Sicilia): Fragrantly floral & peachy; cheerfully chirpy &... look, just drink the hell out of it, ok? \$20

  B+>> find this wine<<
- 14 Ernest Vineyards The Bombardier Chardonnay (Sonoma Coast): I guess that you can be bombarded with subtlety & awesomeness.

  Who knew \$42 A->>find this wine<<
- 15 Bonny Doon Vin Gris de Cigare (Central Coast): One of those rare occasions of easy-going likability displayed both inside and out. \$18 B+ >> find this wine <<
- NV Gerard Bertrand Code Rouge Brut Eternel Blanc de Blancs (Languedoc-Roussillon): Ugly packaging, but not actually ugly drinking. \$26 B >> find this wine <<

• 15 Hecht & Bannier Cotes de Provence Rose (Cotes de Provence): Chalky, cherry-filled, crisp & clean; in other words, a delight. \$18

B+ >>find this wine <<

• 12 Cadaretta Cabernet Sauvignon (Columbia Valley): He's a little self-possessed, but damn, he's so well-dressed it's not even

funny. \$40 A->> find this wine <<
