Today, their children José and Antonio have taken up leading roles in the Donnafugata enterprise and their grandchildren Ferdinando and Gabriella have also become part of it, appearing as adorable Bacchus figures in ads. Their wide range of wines made from both native Sicilian grapes such as Nero d'Avola or Catarratto as well as international varieties like Chardonnay, Cabernet Sauvignon, or Merlot will please any palate.
